



What you need to know about TAPPARELLO First and foremost, "TAPPARELLO" is the result of R&D by BONOMINI S.R.L. from Borgosatollo (BS) - Italy, which also owns the relevant patents. BONOMINI specializes in producing hydraulic equipment, particularly that needed for draining, e.g. plastic traps, fittings and pipes. The company is known in its business for several innovations it has brought on the market, among which the TU.BON.FLEX. multi-layer flexible drainage system.

"TAPPARELLO" is a product meant for the bathroom after market, i.e. it can be used to aesthetically renovate the drains or to repair them, according to your need. It comes with a spring release, it opens and closes with a click, which also makes it particularly nice.

Did you ever happen to see a washbasin with its drain trap worn out by heavy abrasive dust usage? It's a very common situation in hotels, bars, restaurants and common baths at large, where cleaning is made by external companies employing aggressive detergents and abrasive tools which speed up the cleaning.

Or, you could have witnessed a completely oxidized drain trap, its colour turned to yellow-green, perhaps because of saltiness from the nearby seaside or the local water grid, which water is drinkable only after heavy "corrections". The cause could well be simply the drain trap long age and service. In both those cases "TAPPARELLO" is just the solution you need. Easy and quick to install, its big shiny chrome-plated cap, on top of all the gear, completely covers the worn out drain. Exit old unsightly drains, enter happy householders.

Surely some of you have been left with a broken pop-up arm (the metal stick that opens and closes the washbasin plug) in their hands, and had to resort to conjurer's hand tricks and twists in order to extract the plug and flush the water.

More common, and already out of fashion, is the case of the broken plug chain. But some people have to remember to close it tightly lest it become a toy for the house cat or dog, who never remembers where he has left the plug...

Some other poor souls regularly find the drain clogged by their little plumber-to-be's tiny toys! I must admit my toothpaste tube cap is very attracted by the drain.

In these cases, too, "TAPPARELLO" is THE solution. Once screwed down in position it can only be lifted or lowered pressing it with a single finger.

Rotating our gaze 180° inside the bathroom, we would probably see the bathtub. Which is often a source of trouble. The plug open/close knob often gets harder and harder to turn until it jams completely.

If your bathtub drain chooses to jam just when your lying there immersed in water (like mine used to do) there are three solutions to empty it: you can use a bucket (the most uncomfortable solution) a blade sharp enough to get under the plug and lift it (the most spontaneous one) or buy the "TAPPAGUASTI" version of "TAPPARELLO" (surely the smartest move). Above all, this third solution will spare you the need to have a bricklayer break your bathtub containing wall in order to let a plumber replace your old drain, then rebuild the wall again. That is, if you belong to that farsighted elite of people who do keep spare tiles. quindi ripristinare il muretto.

You can install almost all of our TAPPARELLO plugs on your own, except for those who are to be placed on your shower drain, which require a plumber.
